May they experience the help of Christian people, and know the peace that comes from doing God's will.

The Apostles' Creed

First Sorrowful Mystery - The Agony in the Garden Fruit of the Mystery: Conformity to God's will

Second Sorrowful Mystery - The Scourging at the Pillar Fruit of the Mystery: Mortification

As Christ's flesh was torn by the instruments of those who scourged Him, so the bodies of babies in the womb are torn by the instruments of the abortionists. Let us pray that abortionists may repent of these acts of child-killing.

Third Sorrowful Mystery- The Crowning With Thorns

Fruit of the Mystery: Moral Courage

Jesus suffered the pain of thorns in His head, and did so silently. We pray for the healing of the mothers and fathers of aborted children. So many of them suffer deep grief and regret over a choice they can never reverse. So many suffer in silence, because others tell them it's no big deal.
